#### AN ACT

To provide for the conveyance of certain Forest Service land to the city of Coffman Cove, Alaska.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Coffman Cove Admin-
- 5 istrative Site Conveyance Act of 2008".
- 6 SEC. 2. DEFINITIONS.
- 7 In this Act:
- 8 (1) City.—The term "City" means the city of
- 9 Coffman Cove, Alaska.
- 10 (2) Secretary.—The term "Secretary" means
- 11 the Secretary of Agriculture.

#### SEC. 3. CONVEYANCE.

- 2 (a) In General.—Subject to valid existing rights,
- 3 the Secretary shall convey to the City, without consider-
- 4 ation and by quitclaim deed all right, title, and interest
- 5 of the United States, except as provided in subsections (c)
- 6 and (d), in and to the parcel of National Forest System
- 7 land described in subsection (b).
- 8 (b) Description of Land.—
- 9 (1) In General.—The parcel of National For-
- 10 est System land referred to in subsection (a) is the
- approximately 12 acres of land identified in U.S.
- Survey 10099, as depicted on the plat entitled "Sub-
- division of U.S. Survey No. 10099" and recorded as
- 14 Plat 2003–1 on January 21, 2003, Petersburg Re-
- 15 cording District, Alaska.
- 16 (2) EXCLUDED LAND.—The parcel of National
- 17 Forest System land conveyed under subsection (a)
- does not include the portion of U.S. Survey 10099
- that is north of the right-of-way for Forest Develop-
- 20 ment Road 3030–295 and southeast of Tract CC-
- 21 8.
- (c) RIGHT-OF-WAY.—The United States may reserve
- 23 a right-of-way to provide access to the National Forest
- 24 System land excluded from the conveyance to the City
- 25 under subsection (b)(2).

1	(d) Reversion.—If any portion of the land conveyed
2	under subsection (a) (other than a portion of land sold
3	under subsection (e)) ceases to be used for public pur-
4	poses, the land shall, at the option of the Secretary, revert
5	to the United States.
6	(e) Conditions on Subsequent Conveyances.—
7	If the City sells any portion of the land conveyed to the
8	City under subsection (a)—
9	(1) the amount of consideration for the sale
10	shall reflect fair market value, as determined by an
11	appraisal; and
12	(2) the City shall pay to the Secretary an
13	amount equal to the gross proceeds of the sale,
14	which shall be available, without further appropria-
15	tion, for the Tongass National Forest.
