A BILL

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. VETERANS MEMORIAL POST OFFICE.**

4 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States
5 Postal Service located at 110 East Alexander Street in

1 Three Rivers, Texas, shall be known and designated as
2 the “Veterans Memorial Post Office”.

3 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
4 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
5 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
6 be deemed to be a reference to the “Veterans Memorial
7 Post Office”.
