## RESOLUTION

Amending the Rules of the House of Representatives to require that the lists of earmarks be made available to the general public on the Internet.

1       *Resolved*, That clause 9 of rule XXI of the Rules of  
2 the House of Representatives is amended as follows:

3           (1) in paragraph (a)(1), by inserting “, which  
4 shall be made available on the Internet in a search-  
5 able format to the general public for at least 48  
6 hours before consideration,” after “a list”;

1           (2) in paragraph (a)(2), by inserting “, which  
2       shall be made available on the Internet in a search-  
3       able format to the general public for at least 48  
4       hours before consideration,” after “a list”; and

5           (3) in paragraph (a)(4), by inserting “, which  
6       shall be made available on the Internet in a search-  
7       able format to the general public for at least 48  
8       hours before consideration,” after “a list”.
