Mr. SAM JOHNSON of Texas submitted the following resolution; which was referred to the Committee on Rules

---

# RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 511) to pledge the faithful support of Congress to members of the United States Armed Forces serving in harm's way.

1        *Resolved*, That immediately after the adoption of this  
2 resolution the Speaker shall, pursuant to clause 2(b) of  
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee  
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-  
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 511) to pledge the faithful support  
6 of Congress to members of the United States Armed  
7 Forces serving in harm's way. The first reading of the  
8 bill shall be dispensed with. All points of order against  
9 consideration of the bill are waived. General debate shall

1 be confined to the bill and shall not exceed one hour equal-  
2 ly divided and controlled by the chairman and ranking mi-  
3 nority member of the Committee on Armed Services. After  
4 general debate the bill shall be considered for amendment  
5 under the five-minute rule. During consideration of the bill  
6 for amendment, the Chairman of the Committee of the  
7 Whole may accord priority in recognition on the basis of  
8 whether the Member offering an amendment has caused  
9 it to be printed in the portion of the Congressional Record  
10 designated for that purpose in clause 8 of rule XVIII.  
11 Amendments so printed shall be considered as read. At  
12 the conclusion of consideration of the bill for amendment  
13 the Committee shall rise and report the bill to the House  
14 with such amendments as may have been adopted. The  
15 previous question shall be considered as ordered on the  
16 bill and amendments thereto to final passage without in-  
17 tervening motion except one motion to recommit with or  
18 without instructions.

19 SEC. 2. If the Committee of the Whole rises and re-  
20 ports that it has come to no resolution on the bill, then  
21 on the next legislative day the House shall, immediately  
22 after the third daily order of business under clause 1 of  
23 rule XIV, resolve into the Committee of the Whole for fur-  
24 ther consideration of the bill.
