Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 1591) making emergency supplemental appropriations for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2007, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That upon adoption of this resolution it
2 shall be in order to consider in the House the bill (H.R.
3 1591) making emergency supplemental appropriations for
4 the fiscal year ending September 30, 2007, and for other
5 purposes. All points of order against consideration of the
6 bill are waived except those arising under clause 9 or 10
7 of rule XXI. The amendment printed in the report of the

1 Committee on Rules accompanying this resolution shall be
2 considered as adopted. The bill, as amended, shall be con-
3 sidered as read. All points of order against the bill, as
4 amended, are waived. The previous question shall be con-
5 sidered as ordered on the bill, as amended, to final passage
6 without intervening motion except: (1) four hours of de-
7 bate equally divided and controlled by the chairman and
8 ranking minority member of the Committee on Appropria-
9 tions; and (2) one motion to recommit with or without in-
10 structions.

11 SEC. 2. During consideration of H.R. 1591 pursuant
12 to this resolution, notwithstanding the operation of the
13 previous question, the Chair may postpone further consid-
14 eration of the bill to a time designated by the Speaker.
