Mr. SPRATT submitted the following resolution; which was referred to the Committee on Rules, and in addition to the Committee on the Budget, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned

RESOLUTION

To institute a reconciliation rule in the House of
Representatives for the 110th Congress.

1 *Resolved*, That it shall not be in order to consider a
2 concurrent resolution on the budget, or an amendment
3 thereto or a conference report thereon, that contains rec-
4 onciliation directives under section 310 of the Congres-
5 sional Budget Act of 1974 that specify changes in law re-
6 ducing the surplus or increasing the deficit for either the
7 period comprising the current fiscal year and the five fiscal
8 years beginning with the fiscal year that ends in the fol-
9 lowing calendar year or the period comprising the current

1 fiscal year and the ten fiscal years beginning with the fis-
2 cal year that ends in the following calendar year. In deter-
3 mining whether reconciliation directives specify changes in
4 law reducing the surplus or increasing the deficit, the sum
5 of the directives for each reconciliation bill (under section
6 310 of the Congressional Budget Act of 1974) envisioned
7 by that measure shall be evaluated.

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
