1        *Resolved,*

2 **SECTION 1. REFERRAL.**

3        The bill (H.R. 2124), entitled “A bill for the relief  
4 of Adela and Darryl Bailor”, now pending in the House  
5 of Representatives, together with all the accompanying pa-  
6 pers, is referred to the chief judge of the United States  
7 Court of Federal Claims.

1 **SEC. 2. PROCEEDINGS AND REPORT.**

2       Upon receipt of the bill under section 1, the chief  
3 judge shall—

4       (1) proceed under sections 1492 and 2509 of title 28,

5       United States Code; and

6       (2) report back to the House of Representatives, at

7       the earliest practicable date, providing—

8           (A) such findings of fact and conclusions of law  
9       that are sufficient to inform Congress of the nature,  
10       extent and character of the compensation referred to  
11       in the bill as a legal or equitable claim against the  
12       United States; and

13           (B) the amount, if any, legally or equitably due  
14       from the United States to Adela and Darryl Bailor.
