2 XIII for a two-thirds vote to consider a report from the
3 Committee on Rules on the same day it is presented to
4 the House is waived with respect to any resolution re-
5 ported on the legislative day of December 5, 2007, pro-
6 viding for consideration of the Senate amendments to the
7 bill (H.R. 6) to reduce our Nation’s dependency on foreign

1 oil by investing in clean, renewable, and alternative energy
2 resources, promoting new emerging energy technologies,
3 developing greater efficiency, and creating a Strategic En-
4 ergy Efficiency and Renewables Reserve to invest in alter-
5 native energy, and for other purposes.
