RESOLUTION

Providing for the consideration of the Senate amendment to the bill (H.R. 2761) to extend the Terrorism Insurance Program of the Department of the Treasury, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That upon adoption of this resolution it
2 shall be in order to take from the Speaker's table the bill
3 (H.R. 2761) to extend the Terrorism Insurance Program
4 of the Department of the Treasury, and for other pur-
5 poses, with the Senate amendment thereto, and to con-
6 sider in the House, without intervention of any point of

1 order except those arising under clause 10 of rule XXI,
2 a motion offered by the chairman of the Committee on
3 Financial Services or his designee that the House concur
4 in the Senate amendment with the amendment printed in
5 the report of the Committee on Rules accompanying this
6 resolution. The Senate amendment and the motion shall
7 be considered as read. The motion shall be debatable for
8 one hour equally divided and controlled by the chairman
9 and ranking minority member of the Committee on Finan-
10 cial Services. The previous question shall be considered as
11 ordered on the motion to its adoption without intervening
12 motion or demand for division of the question.

13 SEC. 2. During consideration of the motion to concur
14 pursuant to this resolution, notwithstanding the operation
15 of the previous question, the Chair may postpone further
16 consideration of the motion to such time as may be des-
17 ignated by the Speaker.
