RESOLUTION

Waiving a requirement of clause 6(a) of rule XIII with respect to consideration of certain resolutions reported from the Committee on Rules.

1 *Resolved*, That the requirement of clause 6(a) of rule
2 XIII for a two-thirds vote to consider a report from the
3 Committee on Rules on the same day it is presented to
4 the House is waived with respect to any resolution re-
5 ported on the legislative day of December 11, 2007, pro-
6 viding for consideration of the Senate amendment to the
7 bill (H.R. 2764) making appropriations for the Depart-

1 ment of State, foreign operations, and related programs
2 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2008, and for
3 other purposes.

4 SEC. 2. The chairman of the Committee on Appro-
5 priations may insert in the Congressional Record at any
6 time during the remainder of the first session of the 110th
7 Congress such material as he may deem explanatory of
8 appropriations measures for the fiscal year 2008.

9 SEC. 3. House Resolution 839 is laid upon the table.
