A BILL

To authorize the Secretary of the Interior to assist in the planning, design, and construction of the Tumalo Irrigation District Water Conservation Project in Deschutes County, Oregon.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Tumalo Water Con-
3 servation Project Act of 2007”.

4 **SEC. 2. DEFINITIONS.**

5 In this Act:

6 (1) **DISTRICT.**—The term “District” means the
7 Tumalo Irrigation District, Oregon.

8 (2) **PROJECT.**—The term “Project” means the
9 Tumalo Irrigation District Water Conservation
10 Project authorized under section 3(a).

11 (3) **SECRETARY.**—The term “Secretary” means
12 the Secretary of the Interior.

13 **SEC. 3. AUTHORIZATION TO PLAN, DESIGN AND CON-**
14 **STRUCT THE TUMALO WATER CONSERVA-**
15 **TION PROJECT.**

16 (a) **AUTHORIZATION.**—The Secretary, in cooperation
17 with the District—

18 (1) may participate in the planning, design, and
19 construction of the Tumalo Irrigation District Water
20 Conservation Project in Deschutes County, Oregon;
21 and

22 (2) for purposes of planning and designing the
23 Project, shall take into account any appropriate
24 studies and reports prepared by the District.

25 (b) **COST-SHARING REQUIREMENT.**—

1 (1) FEDERAL SHARE.—The Federal share of
2 the total cost of the Project shall be 25 percent,
3 which shall be nonreimbursable to the United States.

4 (2) CREDIT TOWARD NON-FEDERAL SHARE.—
5 The Secretary shall credit toward the non-Federal
6 share of the Project any amounts that the District
7 provides toward the design, planning, and construc-
8 tion before the date of enactment of this Act.

9 (c) TITLE.—The District shall hold title to any facili-
10 ties constructed under this Act.

11 (d) OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE COSTS.—The
12 District shall pay the operation and maintenance costs of
13 the Project.

14 (e) EFFECT.—Any assistance provided under this Act
15 shall not be considered to be a supplemental or additional
16 benefit under Federal reclamation law (the Act of June
17 17, 1902 (32 Stat. 388, chapter 1093), and Acts supple-
18 mental to and amendatory of that Act (43 U.S.C. 371 et
19 seq.).

20 **SEC. 4. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

21 There is authorized to be appropriated to the Sec-
22 retary for the Federal share of the cost of the Project
23 \$4,000,000.

1 **SEC. 5. TERMINATION OF AUTHORITY.**

2 The authority of the Secretary to carry out this Act
3 shall expire on the date that is 10 years after the date
4 of enactment of this Act.
