3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "National Liberty Me-5 morial Act".

1 SEC. 2. FINDING.

Congress finds that the contributions of free persons
and slaves who fought during the American Revolution
were of preeminent historical and lasting significance to
the United States, as required by section 8908(b)(1) of
title 40, United States Code.

7 SEC. 3. THE NATIONAL LIBERTY MEMORIAL.

- (ii) by striking "Federal land in the
 District of Columbia and its environs" and
 inserting "the Federal land in the District
 of Columbia described in subsection (b)";

- 24 (B) by striking the second sentence and in-25 serting the following:

1 "(b) DESCRIPTION OF LAND.—The Federal land re-2 ferred to in subsection (a) is the portion of land at Con-3 stitution Gardens, located on the south side of Constitu-4 tion Lake and west of the island, that was previously se-5 lected as the site for the memorial.

6 "(c) APPLICABLE LAW.—The memorial shall be es7 tablished in accordance with chapter 89 of title 40, United
8 States Code."; and

9 (2) in section 2, by striking "The Black Revolu10 tionary War Patriots Foundation" and inserting
11 "National Mall Liberty Fund D.C.".
