To designate the Federal building and United States Courthouse located at 100 East 8th Avenue in Pine Bluff, Arkansas, as the “George Howard, Jr. Federal Building and United States Courthouse”.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. GEORGE HOWARD, JR. FEDERAL BUILDING**  
2 **AND UNITED STATES COURTHOUSE.**

3 (a) DESIGNATION.—The Federal building and United  
4 States Courthouse, located at 100 East 8th Avenue in  
5 Pine Bluff, Arkansas, shall be known and designated as  
6 the “George Howard, Jr. Federal Building and United  
7 States Courthouse”.

8 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-  
9 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United  
10 States to the Federal building and United States Court-  
11 house referred to in subsection (a) shall be deemed to be  
12 a reference to the “George Howard, Jr. Federal Building  
13 and United States Courthouse”.
