3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Montgomery GI Bill
- 5 for Life Act of 2007".

SEC. 2. REPEAL OF 10-YEAR LIMIT ON USE OF VETERANS EDUCATIONAL ASSISTANCE BENEFITS. (a) RESTATEMENT OF CERTAIN CONTINUING AU THORITIES WITH REPEAL.—Section 3031 of title 38,

5 United States Code, is amended to read as follows:

6 "§ 3031. Extension of entitlement expiring during 7 quarter or semester or after completion 8 of major portion of course

9 "(a) If an individual eligible for educational assist-10 ance under this chapter is enrolled in an educational insti-11 tution regularly operated on the quarter or semester sys-12 tem and the period of such individual's entitlement under 13 this chapter would, under section 3013 of this title, expire 14 during such quarter or semester, such period shall be ex-15 tended to the end of such quarter or semester.

16 "(b) If an individual eligible for educational assistance under this chapter is enrolled in an educational insti-17 18 tution not regularly operated on the quarter or semester 19 system and the period of such individual's entitlement 20under this chapter would, under section 3013 of this title, 21 expire after a major portion of the course is completed, 22 such period shall be extended to the end of the course or 23 for 12 weeks, whichever is the lesser period of extension.". 24 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENTS.—Chapter 30 of such title is further amended as follows: 25

9 SEC. 4. REPEAL OF TIME LIMITATION ON USE BY DISABLED

10MEMBERS OF EDUCATIONAL ASSISTANCE11FOR RESERVE COMPONENT MEMBERS SUP-12PORTING CONTINGENCY AND OTHER OPER-13ATIONS.

14 Subsection (b) of section 16164 of title 10, United15 States Code, is amended to read as follows:

16 "(b) ENTITLEMENT OF DISABLED MEMBERS.—(1) The maximum number of months of educational assist-17 ance under this chapter to which is entitled a person who 18 19 is separated from the Ready Reserve because of a dis-20 ability which was not the result of the person's own wilful 21 misconduct incurred on or after the date on which the per-22 son became entitled to educational assistance under this 23 chapter shall be governed by section 16162(d) of this title.

"(2) The provisions of section 3031 of title 38 shall
 apply to the entitlement to educational assistance under
 this chapter of a person covered by paragraph (1).".
