## AN ACT

To create and extend certain temporary district court  
judgeships.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. TEMPORARY JUDGEShips FOR DISTRICT**  
 2 **COURTS.**

3 (a) ADDITIONAL TEMPORARY JUDGEShips.—

4 (1) IN GENERAL.—The President shall appoint,  
 5 by and with the advice and consent of the Senate—

6 (A) 1 additional district judge for the east-  
 7 ern district of California; and

8 (B) 1 additional district judge for the dis-  
 9 trict of Nebraska.

10 (2) VACANCIES NOT FILLED.—The first va-  
 11 cancy in the office of district judge in each of the  
 12 offices of district judge authorized by this sub-  
 13 section, occurring 10 years or more after the con-  
 14 firmation date of the judge named to fill the tem-  
 15 porary district judgeship created in the applicable  
 16 district by this subsection, shall not be filled.

17 (b) EXTENSION OF CERTAIN TEMPORARY JUDGE-  
 18 SHIPS.—Section 203(c) of the Judicial Improvements Act  
 19 of 1990 (Public Law 101–650; 28 U.S.C. 133 note) is  
 20 amended—

21 (1) in the second sentence, by inserting “the  
 22 district of Hawaii,” after “Pennsylvania,”;

23 (2) in the third sentence (relating to the district  
 24 of Kansas), by striking “16 years” and inserting  
 25 “26 years”;
