## A BILL

To amend chapter 35 of title 28, United States Code, to strike the exception to the residency requirements for United States attorneys.

**3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “United States Attorney  
5 Local Residency Restoration Act of 2007”.

**6 SEC. 2. REPEAL OF RESIDENCY EXCEPTION.**

7       (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 545(a) of title 28, United  
8 States Code, is amended by striking the last sentence.
