3 **SECTION 1. TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE.**

4 Section 1442(e) of the Safe Drinking Water Act (42
5 U.S.C. 300j-1(e)) is amended in the fifth sentence by

1 striking “1997 through 2003” and inserting “2008
2 through 2012”. striking “1997 through 2003.” and insert-
3 ing the following: “2008 through 2012. In providing grants
4 under this section, the Administrator shall give priority to
5 small systems organizations that, as determined by the Ad-
6 ministrator, are qualified and will be most effective at as-
7 sisting those small systems that have the greatest need (or
8 a majority of need) in the States.”.
