Mrs. BOXER introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Finance

A BILL

To amend part E of title IV of the Social Security Act to expand Federal eligibility for children in foster care who have attained age 18.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Foster Care Con-
5 tinuing Opportunities Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. STATE OPTION FOR YOUTH TO ELECT TO REMAIN** 7 **IN FOSTER CARE AFTER ATTAINING AGE 18.**

8 (a) DEFINITION OF CHILD.—Section 475 of the So-
9 cial Security Act (42 U.S.C. 675) is amended by adding
10 at the end the following new paragraph:

1 “(8)(A) Subject to subparagraph (B), the term
 2 ‘child’ means an individual who has not attained age
 3 18.

4 “(B) At the option of a State, such term may
 5 include an individual who—

6 “(i) has attained age 18; and

7 “(ii) elects to remain in foster care until
 8 attaining age 19, 20, or 21 (as the State may
 9 elect).”.

10 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENTS.—Section 477 of
 11 such Act (42 U.S.C. 677) is amended—

12 (1) in subsection (a)—

13 (A) in paragraphs (1), (2), and (3) by in-
 14 serting “(or such higher age as the State has
 15 elected under section 475(8)” after “of age”
 16 each place it appears; and

17 (B) in paragraph (5), by inserting “(or be-
 18 tween such higher age as the State has elected
 19 under section 475(8) and 21 years of age)”
 20 after “18 and 21 years of age”; and

21 (2) in subparagraphs (A), (B), and (C) of sub-
 22 section (b)(3), by inserting “(or such higher age as
 23 the State has elected under section 475(8))” after
 24 “18 years of age” each place it appears.

1 (c) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
2 this section take effect on October 1, 2007.
