- 2        **SECTION 1. DR. KARL E. CARSON POST OFFICE BUILDING.**
- 3        (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States
- 4        Postal Service located at 301 Boardwalk Drive in Fort

1 Collins, Colorado, shall be known and designated as the  
2 "Dr. Karl E. Carson Post Office Building".

3 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-  
4 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United  
5 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall  
6 be deemed to be a reference to the "Dr. Karl E. Carson  
7 Post Office Building".
