A BILL

To reauthorize the African Elephant Conservation Act, the Rhinoceros and Tiger Conservation Act of 1994, and the Asian Elephant Conservation Act of 1997.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Multinational Species
5 Conservation Funds Reauthorization Act of 2007”.

6 **SEC. 2. REAUTHORIZATION OF AFRICAN ELEPHANT CON-
7 SERVATION ACT.**

8 Section 2306(a) of the African Elephant Conserva-
9 tion Act (16 U.S.C. 4245(a)) is amended by striking

1 “2001, 2002, 2003, 2004, 2005, 2006, and 2007” and
2 inserting “2007 through 2012”.

3 **SEC. 3. REAUTHORIZATION OF RHINOCEROS AND TIGER**
4 **CONSERVATION ACT OF 1994.**

5 Section 10(a) of the Rhinoceros and Tiger Conserva-
6 tion Act of 1994 (16 U.S.C. 5306(a)) is amended by strik-
7 ing “2001, 2002, 2003, 2004, 2005, 2006, and 2007” and
8 inserting “2007 through 2012”.

9 **SEC. 4. REAUTHORIZATION OF ASIAN ELEPHANT CON-**
10 **SERVATION ACT OF 1997.**

11 Section 8(a) of the Asian Elephant Conservation Act
12 of 1997 (16 U.S.C. 4266(a)) is amended by striking
13 “2001, 2002, 2003, 2004, 2005, 2006, and 2007” and
14 inserting “2007 through 2012”.
