1 **SECTION 1. FUNDING FOR KEWEENAW NATIONAL HISTOR-**
 2 **ICAL PARK.**

3 (a) ACQUISITION OF PROPERTY.—Section 4 of Public
 4 Law 102–543 (16 U.S.C. 410yy–3) is amended by striking
 5 subsection (d).

6 (b) MATCHING FUNDS.—Section 8(b) of Public Law
 7 102–543 (16 U.S.C. 410yy–7(b)) is amended by striking
 8 “\$4” and inserting “\$1”.

9 (c) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—Section
 10 10 of Public Law 102–543 (16 U.S.C. 410yy–9) is amend-
 11 ed—

12 (1) in subsection (a)—

13 (A) by striking “\$25,000,000” and insert-
 14 ing “\$50,000,000”; and

15 (B) by striking “\$3,000,000” and insert-
 16 ing “\$25,000,000”; and

17 (2) in subsection (b), by striking “\$100,000”
 18 and all that follows through “those duties” and in-
 19 serting “\$250,000”.
