3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Medicare Safe Needle
5 Disposal Coverage Act of 2007”.

1 **SEC. 2. COVERAGE OF HOME NEEDLE REMOVAL, DECON-**
2 **TAMINATION, AND DISPOSAL DEVICES AND**
3 **DISPOSAL OF NEEDLES AND SYRINGES**
4 **THROUGH A SHARPS-BY-MAIL OR SIMILAR**
5 **PROGRAM UNDER MEDICARE PART D.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 1860D–2(e)(1)(B) of the
7 Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1395w–102(e)(1)(B)) is
8 amended by inserting after “regulations of the Secretary”
9 the following: “and including devices approved for home
10 use by the Food and Drug Administration for the safe
11 and effective removal, decontamination, and disposal of
12 needles and the disposal of needles and syringes through
13 a sharps-by-mail or similar program as medically appro-
14 priate based on volume of usage”.

15 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
16 subsection (a) shall take effect on January 1, 2008.

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
