A BILL

To authorize appropriations for assistance for the Housing Assistance Council, the Raza Development Fund, and for the Housing Partnership Network (HPN) and its members, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Housing Assistance
- 5 Authorization Act of 2007".

1 SEC. 2. LIMITATION ON USE OF AUTHORIZED AMOUNTS.

- None of the amounts authorized by this Act may be
- 3 used to lobby or retain a lobbyist for the purpose of influ-
- 4 encing a Federal, State, or local governmental entity or
- 5 officer.

6 SEC. 3. ASSISTANCE TO HOUSING ASSISTANCE COUNCIL.

- 7 (a) USE.—The Secretary of Housing and Urban De-
- 8 velopment may provide financial assistance to the Housing
- 9 Assistance Council for use by such Council to develop the
- 10 ability and capacity of community-based housing develop-
- 11 ment organizations to undertake community development
- 12 and affordable housing projects and programs in rural
- 13 areas. Assistance provided by the Secretary under this sec-
- 14 tion may be used by the Housing Assistance Council for—
- 15 (1) technical assistance, training, support, and
- advice to develop the business and administrative ca-
- pabilities of rural community-based housing develop-
- ment organizations;
- 19 (2) loans, grants, or other financial assistance
- to rural community-based housing development orga-
- 21 nizations to carry out community development and
- affordable housing activities for low- and moderate-
- 23 income families; and
- 24 (3) such other activities as may be determined
- by the Secretary and the Housing Assistance Coun-
- 26 cil.

1	(b) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There is
2	authorized to be appropriated for financial assistance
3	under this section for the Housing Assistance Council—
4	(1) \$5,000,000 for fiscal year 2008; and
5	(2) \$10,000,000 for each of fiscal years 2009
6	and 2010.
7	SEC. 4. ASSISTANCE FOR RAZA DEVELOPMENT FUND.
8	(a) USE.—The Secretary of Housing and Urban De-
9	velopment may make a grant to the Raza Development
10	Fund for the purpose of providing technical and financial
11	assistance to local non-profit organizations to undertake
12	community development and affordable housing projects
13	and programs serving low- and moderate-income house-
14	holds, particularly through organizations located in neigh-
15	borhoods with substantial populations of income-disadvan-
16	taged households of Hispanic origin. Assistance provided
17	by the Secretary under this section may be used by the
18	Raza Development Fund to—
19	(1) provide technical and financial assistance
20	for site acquisition and development, construction fi-
21	nancing, and short- and long-term financing for
22	housing, community facilities, and economic develop-
23	ment;

1	(2) leverage capital from private entities, in-
2	cluding private financial institutions, insurance com-
3	panies, and private philanthropic organizations;
4	(3) provide technical assistance, training, sup-
5	port, and advice to develop the management, finan-
6	cial, and administrative capabilities of housing devel-
7	opment organizations serving low-income households,
8	including Hispanic households; and
9	(4) conduct such other activities as may be de-
10	termined by the Secretary and the Raza Develop-
11	ment Fund.
12	(b) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There is
13	authorized to be appropriated for grants under this sec-
14	tion—
15	(1) \$5,000,000 for fiscal year 2008; and
16	(2) \$10,000,000 for each of fiscal years 2009
17	and 2010.
18	SEC. 5. ASSISTANCE FOR THE HOUSING PARTNERSHIP NET-
19	WORK.
20	(a) USE.—The Secretary of Housing and Urban De-
21	velopment may make a grant to the Housing Partnership
22	Network (hereafter referred to as the "Network") for the
23	purpose of creating, sustaining, and improving access to
24	affordable housing and community facilities that benefit
25	very low-, low- and moderate-income households and com-

- 1 munities. Assistance provided by the Secretary under this
- 2 section may be used by the Network to—
- 1) make investments, loans, and grants to its
 member nonprofits that demonstrate expertise in
 using such funds to leverage additional private capital to build, operate, finance, and sustain affordable
 housing and related community development facilities;
 - (2) make investments in entities sponsored by the Network with the intent to leverage additional private capital for the purpose of furthering the production capacity, sustainability, or efficiency of its members;
 - (3) pay for the necessary and reasonable expenses of the Network to administer and oversee such investments, including the cost of underwriting, managing the assets of the Network, and reporting to the Secretary and other capital providers, provided however, that such expenses do not exceed 6 percent of any amounts made available pursuant to subsection (b); and
 - (4) conduct such other activities as may be determined by the Secretary and the Network.

1 (b) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There is 2 authorized to be appropriated for grants under this sec-3 tion— 4 (1) \$5,000,000 for fiscal year 2008; and (2) \$10,000,000 for each of fiscal years 2009 6 and 2010. 7 SEC. 6. AUDITS AND REPORTS. 8 (a) AUDIT.—In any year in which an entity or organization described under either section 3, 4, or 5 receives 10 funds under this Act, the Comptroller General of the United States shall— 12 (1) audit the financial transactions and activi-13 ties of such entity or organization only with respect 14 to such funds so received; and 15 (2) submit a report detailing such audit to the 16 Committee on Banking, Housing, and Urban Affairs 17 of the Senate and the Committee on Financial Serv-18 ices of the House of Representatives. 19 (b) GAO REPORT.—The Comptroller General of the 20 United States shall conduct a study and submit a report 21 to the Committee on Banking, Housing, and Urban Affairs of the Senate and the Committee on Financial Services of the House of Representative on the use of any funds appropriated to an entity or organization described

under either section 3, 4, or 5 over the past 10 years.

1 SEC. 7. PERSONS NOT LAWFULLY PRESENT IN THE UNITED

- 2 STATES.
- 3 None of the funds made available under this Act may
- 4 be used to provide direct housing assistance to any person
- 5 not lawfully present in the United States.
