An in-10 creased pension shall be paid to the veteran at the rate prescribed by subsection (e) of section 1521 of this title if the veteran has a permanent and total disability and either has additional disability or disabilities independ-14 ently ratable at 60 per centum or more, or by reason of 15 a disability or disabilities is permanently housebound but does not qualify for pension at the aid and attendance 16
