A BILL

To amend title 38, United States Code, to clarify the
eligibility criteria for special monthly pension.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SPECIAL MONTHLY PENSION FOR WARTIME**

4 **VETERANS 65 YEARS OF AGE AND OLDER.**

5 (a) APPLICATION OF 38 U.S.C. 1513 IN DETERMINA-
6 TION OF ELIGIBILITY FOR PENSION UNDER 38 U.S.C.
7 1521.—

8 (1) Section 1513(a) of title 38, United States
9 Code, is amended by adding “in subsection (a) of

1 section 1521” immediately following “(other than
2 the permanent and total disability requirement”.

3 (2) Section 1513 of title 38, United States
4 Code, is amended by adding a new subsection (c),
5 which provides the following:

6 “(c) If a veteran is eligible for basic pension under
7 this section, an increased pension shall be paid to the vet-
8 eran if the veteran meets the conditions applicable for an
9 increased pension under section 1521 of this title. An in-
10 creased pension shall be paid to the veteran at the rate
11 prescribed by subsection (e) of section 1521 of this title
12 if the veteran has a permanent and total disability and
13 either has additional disability or disabilities independ-
14 ently ratable at 60 per centum or more, or by reason of
15 a disability or disabilities is permanently housebound but
16 does not qualify for pension at the aid and attendance
17 rate.”.
