AN ACT

To amend the Do-Not-Call Implementation Act to eliminate the automatic removal of telephone numbers registered on the Federal “do-not-call” registry.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Do-Not-Call Improve-
5 ment Act of 2007”.

1 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION OF EXPIRATION DATE FOR REG-**
2 **ISTERED TELEPHONE NUMBERS.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—The registration of a telephone
4 number on the do-not-call registry of the Telemarketing
5 Sales Rule (16 C.F.R. 310.4(b)(1)(iii)) shall not expire at
6 the end of any specified time period.

7 (b) REINSTATEMENT.—The Federal Trade Commis-
8 sion shall reinstate the registration of any telephone num-
9 ber that has been removed from the registry before the
10 date of enactment of this Act under a Federal Trade Com-
11 mission rule or practice requiring the removal of a tele-
12 phone number from the registry 5 years after its registra-
13 tion.

14 (c) REGISTRY MAINTENANCE.—The Federal Trade
15 Commission may check telephone numbers listed on the
16 do-not-call registry against national databases periodically
17 and purge those numbers that have been disconnected and
18 reassigned.

19 **SEC. 3. REPORT ON ACCURACY.**

20 Not later than 9 months after the enactment of this
21 Act, the Federal Trade Commission shall report to the
22 Congress on efforts taken by the Commission, after the

1 date of enactment of this Act, to improve the accuracy
2 of the “do-not-call” Registry.
