#### A BILL

- To direct the Secretary of Agriculture to convey certain land in the Beaverhead-Deerlodge National Forest, Montana, to Jefferson County, Montana, for use as a cemetery.
  - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
  - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

#### SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 2 This Act may be cited as the "Montana Cemetery Act
- 3 of 2007".
- 4 SEC. 2. DEFINITIONS.
- 5 In this Act:
- 6 (1) COUNTY.—The term "County" means Jef-
- 7 ferson County, Montana.
- 8 (2) MAP.—The term "map" means the map
- 9 that is—
- (A) entitled "Elkhorn Cemetery";
- 11 (B) dated May 9, 2005; and
- 12 (C) on file in the office of the Beaverhead-
- 13 Deerlodge National Forest Supervisor.
- 14 (3) Secretary.—The term "Secretary" means
- 15 the Secretary of Agriculture.
- 16 SEC. 3. CONVEYANCE TO JEFFERSON COUNTY, MONTANA.
- 17 (a) CONVEYANCE.—Not later than 180 days after the
- 18 date of enactment of this Act and subject to valid existing
- 19 rights, the Secretary (acting through the Regional For-
- 20 ester, Northern Region, Missoula, Montana) shall convey
- 21 by quitclaim deed to the County for no consideration, all
- 22 right, title, and interest of the United States, except as
- 23 provided in subsection (e), in and to the parcel of land
- 24 described in subsection (b).
- 25 (b) Description of Land.—The parcel of land re-
- 26 ferred to in subsection (a) is the parcel of approximately

- 1 9.67 acres of National Forest System land (including any
- 2 improvements to the land) in the County that is known
- 3 as the "Elkhorn Cemetery", as generally depicted on the
- 4 map.
- 5 (c) USE OF LAND.—As a condition of the conveyance
- 6 under subsection (a), the County shall—
- 7 (1) use the land described in subsection (b) as
- 8 a County cemetery; and
- 9 (2) agree to manage the cemetery with due con-
- sideration and protection for the historic and cul-
- tural values of the cemetery, under such terms and
- conditions as are agreed to by the Secretary and the
- County.
- 14 (d) EASEMENT.—In conveying the land to the County
- 15 under subsection (a), the Secretary, in accordance with
- 16 applicable law, shall grant to the County an easement
- 17 across certain National Forest System land, as generally
- 18 depicted on the map, to provide access to the land con-
- 19 veyed under that subsection.
- 20 (e) Reversion.—In the quitclaim deed to the Coun-
- 21 ty, the Secretary shall provide that the land conveyed to
- 22 the County under subsection (a) shall revert to the Sec-
- 23 retary, at the election of the Secretary, if the land is—
- 24 (1) used for a purpose other than the purposes
- described in subsection (c)(1); or

- 1 (2) managed by the County in a manner that
- 2 is inconsistent with subsection (e)(2).
