1	(1) In General.—Section $143(l)(3)(B)(ii)$ of
2	the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 is amended to
3	read as follows:
4	"(ii) Alaska, oregon, and wis-
5	consin.—In the case of the following
6	States, the State veterans limit for any cal-
7	endar year is the amount equal to—
8	"(I) \$100,000,000 for the State
9	of Alaska,
10	"(II) \$100,000,000 for the State
11	of Oregon, and
12	"(III) $$100,000,000$ for the
13	State of Wisconsin.".
14	(2) Repeal of Phasein.—Section
15	143(l)(3)(B) of such Code is amended by striking
16	clause (iii).
17	(b) Definition of Qualified Veteran.—Para-
18	graph (4) of section 143(l) of the Internal Revenue Code
19	of 1986 is amended to read as follows:
20	"(4) Qualified veteran.—For purposes of
21	this subsection, the term 'qualified veteran' means
22	any veteran—
23	"(A) who served on active duty, and

1	"(B) who applied for the financing before
2	the date 25 years after the last date on which
3	such veteran left active service.".
4	(c) Effective Date.—The amendments made by
5	this section shall apply to bonds issued after December
6	31. 2007.
