5	OVERSEAS PRODUCTION FACILITIES.
6	Subject to the availability of appropriations, not later
7	than October 1, 2008, the Consumer Product Safety Com-
8	mission shall increase the number of full-time personnel
9	assigned to duty stations at United States ports of entry
10	or to inspect overseas production facilities to not less than
11	50.
