Mr. TESTER introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred
to the Committee on Finance

A BILL

To improve the efficiency of customs and other services at
the Wild Horse, Montana port of entry.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. IMPROVED CUSTOMS SERVICES AT WILD**
4 **HORSE, MONTANA PORT OF ENTRY.**

5 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Sec-
6 retary of Homeland Security, not later than 60 days after
7 the date of the enactment of this Act, shall—

8 (1) designate Wild Horse, Montana as a port of
9 entry pursuant to chapter 223 of the Act of August
10 1, 1914 (19 U.S.C. 2); and

1 (2) assign sufficient United States Customs and
2 Border Protection personnel and allocate sufficient
3 equipment to the port of entry at Wild Horse, Mon-
4 tana to accept entries of merchandise, clear pas-
5 sengers, collect duties, and enforce provisions of cus-
6 toms and related laws at such port of entry for 24
7 hours per day.
