A BILL

To improve the efficiency of customs and other services at the Wild Horse, Montana port of entry.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, 3 SECTION 1. IMPROVED CUSTOMS SERVICES AT WILD 4 HORSE, MONTANA PORT OF ENTRY. 5 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Secretary of Homeland Security, not later than 60 days after 7 the date of the enactment of this Act, shall— 8 (1) designate Wild Horse, Montana as a port of 9 entry pursuant to chapter 223 of the Act of August

1, 1914 (19 U.S.C. 2); and

1 (2) assign sufficient United States Customs and
2 Border Protection personnel and allocate sufficient
3 equipment to the port of entry at Wild Horse, Mon4 tana to accept entries of merchandise, clear pas5 sengers, collect duties, and enforce provisions of cus6 toms and related laws at such port of entry for 24
7 hours per day.
