A BILL

To prohibit an entity under the jurisdiction of a Federal agency from paying for travel by employees of that agency.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Restoring Trust in
5 Regulator Travel Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION.**

7 A Federal agency and any employee of that agency
8 may not accept funding for travel from a nonfederal entity

- 1 if the nonfederal entity has been subject to the jurisdiction
- 2 of that agency within 2 years of the travel.
