A BILL

To amend the International Center Act to authorize the lease or sublease of certain property described in such Act to an entity other than a foreign government or international organization if certain conditions are met.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT TO THE INTERNATIONAL CENTER**
4 **ACT.**

5 The first section of the International Center Act
6 (Public Law 90–553; 82 Stat. 958) is amended by adding
7 at the end the following new sentence: “Notwithstanding
8 the foregoing limitations, the property identified by the

1 District of Columbia as tax lots 803, 804, 805, and 806
2 within the area described in this section may be leased
3 or subleased to an entity other than a foreign government
4 or international organization, so long as the Secretary
5 maintains the right to approve the occupant and the in-
6 tended use of the property.”.
