**A BILL**

To make permanent the authorization for watershed restoration and enhancement agreements.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Watershed Restoration  
5 and Enhancement Agreements Act of 2007”.

1 **SEC. 2. WATERSHED RESTORATION AND ENHANCEMENT**  
2 **AGREEMENTS.**

3 Section 323 of the Department of the Interior and  
4 Related Agencies Appropriations Act, 1999 (16 U.S.C.  
5 1011 note; Public Law 105–277), is amended—

6 (1) in subsection (a), by striking “each of fiscal  
7 years 2006 through 2011” and inserting “fiscal year  
8 2006 and each fiscal year thereafter”;

9 (2) by redesignating subsection (d) as sub-  
10 section (e); and

11 (3) by inserting after subsection (c) the fol-  
12 lowing:

13 “(d) **APPLICABLE LAW.**—Chapter 63 of title 31,  
14 United States Code, shall not apply to—

15 “(1) a watershed restoration and enhancement  
16 agreement entered into under this section; or

17 “(2) an agreement entered into under the first  
18 section of Public Law 94–148 (16 U.S.C. 565a–1).”.
