A BILL

To amend the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act to provide adequate case management services.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Case Management
5 Services Improvement Act of 2007”.

6 **SEC. 2. CASE MANAGEMENT SERVICES.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 426 of the Robert T.
8 Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act
9 (42 U.S.C. 5189d) is amended by striking “qualified pri-
10 vate organizations” and inserting “nonprofit or faith-

1 based organizations with experience in case management
2 services”.

3 (b) APPLICABILITY.—Section 426 of the Robert T.
4 Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act
5 (42 U.S.C. 5189d), as amended by this Act, shall apply
6 to any major disaster (as that term is defined in section
7 102 of the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emer-
8 gency Assistance Act (42 U.S.C. 5122)) declared on or
9 after January 1, 2005.
