## A BILL

To increase the annual salaries of justices and judges of the United States, and to increase fees for bankruptcy trustees.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Fair Judicial Com-
- 5 pensation Act of 2007".
- 6 SEC. 2. JUDICIAL SALARY INCREASE.
- 7 (a) In General.—The annual salaries of the Chief
- 8 Justice of the United States, associate justices of the Su-
- 9 preme Court of the United States, United States circuit
- 10 judges, United States district judges, and judges of the

- 1 United States Court of International Trade are increased
- 2 in the amount of 16.5 percent of their respective annual
- 3 salary rates in effect on the effective date of this Act,
- 4 rounded to the nearest \$100 (or, if midway between mul-
- 5 tiples of \$100, to the next higher multiple of \$100).
- 6 (b) Coordination Rule.—If a pay adjustment
- 7 under subsection (a) is to be made for an office or position
- 8 as of the same date that any other pay adjustment would
- 9 take effect for such office or position, the adjustment
- 10 under this Act shall be made first.
- 11 (c) Effective Date.—This section shall take effect
- 12 on the first day of the first applicable pay period beginning
- 13 on or after the date of enactment of this Act.
- 14 SEC. 3. BANKRUPTCY TRUSTEES.
- Section 330(b)(2) of title 11, United States Code, is
- 16 amended, in the undesignated matter following subpara-
- $17\,$  graph (B), by striking "\$15" each place that term appears
- 18 and inserting "\$55".
- 19 SEC. 4. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.
- There are authorized to be appropriated such sums
- 21 as may be necessary to carry out this Act.
