A BILL

To authorize the voluntary purchase of certain properties in Treece, Kansas, endangered by the Cherokee County National Priorities List Site, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY AU-
- 4 THORITY.
- 5 (a) AUTHORIZATION.—The Administrator of the En-
- 6 vironmental Protection Agency shall make available to the
- 7 State of Kansas in fiscal year 2009 not more than
- 8 \$6,000,000 for use by the State in accordance with sub-
- 9 section (b).

1	(b) Use of Funds by State.—
2	(1) In general.—The State of Kansas shall—
3	(A) deposit the amounts received under
4	subsection (a) into the fund established under
5	Kansas House Bill 2168 (2007), entitled "An
6	Act concerning certain communities within
7	superfund sites; providing for relocation and
8	other assistance." and enacted on July 13,
9	2007 (2007 Kan. Sess. Laws 17); and
10	(B) use the amounts in accordance with
11	that bill for the purpose of—
12	(i) purchasing, with the consent of the
13	property owners, the properties described
14	in paragraph (2); and
15	(ii) providing relocation assistance to
16	the residents of those properties.
17	(2) Description of Properties.—The prop-
18	erties referred to in paragraph (1) are—
19	(A) properties in Treece, Kansas, that are
20	in danger of being destroyed by subsidence re-
21	lating to, and that may endanger the health of
22	occupants as a result of risks posed by, the
23	Cherokee County National Priorities List Site;
24	and

1	(B) residential properties of water cus-
2	tomers of Picher, Oklahoma, residing in or near
3	Treece, Kansas.
4	(c) Limitation.—The Uniform Relocation Assist-
5	ance and Real Property Acquisition Policies Act of 1970
6	(42 U.S.C. 4601 et seq.) shall not apply to any use of
7	funds in accordance with this section.
