A BILL

To require the Federal Communications Commission to either grant or deny a Petition for Reconsideration within 1 year after such Petition is first submitted.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Efficiency in Decision
5 Making Act of 2007”.

6 **SEC. 2. EFFICIENT DISPOSITION OF PETITIONS FOR RE-**
7 **CONSIDERATION.**

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 1 year after the
9 submission of a Petition for Reconsideration, the Federal

1 Communications Commission shall make a decision and
2 issue a Memorandum Opinion and Order that either
3 grants or denies such Petition.

4 (b) FAILURE TO COMPLY.—If the Federal Commu-
5 nications Commission fails to comply with the time re-
6 quirements of subsection (a) with respect to any Petition
7 for Reconsideration, such Petition shall be deemed grant-
8 ed.
