A BILL

To direct the Secretary of Education to establish and maintain a public website through which individuals may find a complete database of available scholarships, fellowships, and other programs of financial assistance in the study of science, technology, engineering, and mathematics.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "National STEM Schol-
- 5 arship Database Act".

1	SEC. 2. NATIONAL DATABASE ON FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE
2	FOR STUDY OF SCIENCE, TECHNOLOGY, EN-
3	GINEERING, AND MATHEMATICS.
4	(a) Establishment and Maintenance of Data-
5	BASE.—
6	(1) Database.—The Secretary of Education
7	shall establish and maintain, on the public website
8	of the Department of Education, a database con-
9	sisting of information on scholarships, fellowships,
10	and other programs of financial assistance available
11	from public and private sources for the study of
12	science, technology, engineering, or mathematics at
13	the post-secondary and post-baccalaureate levels.
14	(2) Presentation of information.—The in-
15	formation maintained on the database established
16	under this section shall be displayed on the website
17	in the following manner:
18	(A) Separate information shall be provided
19	for each of the fields of study referred to in
20	paragraph (1) and for post-secondary and post-
21	baccalaureate programs of financial assistance.
22	(B) The database shall provide specific in-
23	formation on any programs of financial assist-
24	ance which are targeted to individuals of a par-
25	ticular gender, ethnicity, or other demographic
26	group.

- 1 (C) If the sponsor of any program of fi-2 nancial assistance included on the database 3 maintains a public website, the database shall 4 provide hyperlinks to the website.
 - (D) In addition to providing the hyperlink to the website of a sponsor of a program of financial assistance as required under subparagraph (C), the database shall provide general information that an interested person may use to contact the sponsor, including the sponsor's electronic mail address.
 - (E) The database shall have a search capability which permits an individual to search for information on the basis of each category of the information provided and on the basis of combinations of categories of the information provided, including whether the scholarship is need- or merit-based and by relevant academic majors.
 - (F) The database shall include a recommendation that students and families should carefully review all of the application requirements prior to applying for aid, and a disclaimer that the scholarships presented in the database are not provided or endorsed by the

- 3 (b) Dissemination of Information on Data-
- 4 BASE.—The Secretary shall take such actions as may be
- 5 necessary on an ongoing basis, including sending notices
- 6 to secondary schools and institutions of higher education,
- 7 to disseminate information on the database established
- 8 and maintained under this Act and to encourage its use
- 9 by interested parties.
- 10 (c) Use of Vendor To Obtain Information.—In
- 11 carrying out this Act, the Secretary of Education shall
- 12 enter into a contract with a private entity under which
- 13 the entity shall furnish and regularly update all of the in-
- 14 formation required to be maintained on the database es-
- 15 tablished under this section.
- 16 (d) Encouraging the Provision of Informa-
- 17 Tion.—In carrying out this Act, the Secretary of Edu-
- 18 cation and the contracted entity shall consult with public
- 19 and private sources of scholarships and make easily avail-
- 20 able a process for such entities to provide regular and up-
- 21 dated information.
