A BILL

To address emergency shortages in food banks.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. EMERGENCY FUNDING.
- 4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Out of any funds in the Treasury
- 5 not otherwise appropriated, the Secretary of the Treasury
- 6 shall transfer to the Secretary of Agriculture to carry out
- 7 the emergency food assistance program established under
- 8 the Emergency Food Assistance Act of 1983 (7 U.S.C.
- 9 7501 et seq.) \$40,000,000, to remain available until ex-
- 10 pended.
- 11 (b) RECEIPT AND ACCEPTANCE.—The Secretary
- 12 shall be entitled to receive, shall accept, and shall use to

- 1 carry out this section the funds transferred under sub-
- 2 section (a), without further appropriation.
