## A BILL

To provide for the release of any reversionary interest of the United States in and to certain lands in Reno, Nevada.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. RAILROAD LANDS DEFINED.
- 4 For the purposes of this Act, the term "railroad
- 5 lands" means those lands within the City of Reno, Ne-
- 6 vada, located within portions of sections 10, 11, and 12
- 7 of T.19 N., R. 19 E., and portions of section 7 of T.19
- 8 N., R. 20 E., Mount Diablo Meridian, Nevada, that were
- 9 originally granted to the Union Pacific Railroad under the

- 1 provisions of the Act of July 1, 1862, commonly known
- 2 as the Union Pacific Railroad Act.
- 3 SEC. 2. RELEASE OF REVERSIONARY INTEREST.
- 4 Any reversionary interests of the United States (in-
- 5 cluding interests under the Act of July 1, 1862, commonly
- 6 known as the Union Pacific Railroad Act) in and to the
- 7 railroad lands as defined in section one of this Act are
- 8 hereby released.
