 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

1 SECTION 1. GRANT OF FEDERAL CHARTER TO MILITARY 2

OFFICERS ASSOCIATION OF AMERICA.

3 (a) GRANT OF CHARTER.—Part B of subtitle II of

- title 36, United States Code, is amended by inserting after 4
- 5 chapter 1403 the following new chapter:

"CHAPTER 1404—MILITARY OFFICERS 6

8 "§ 140401. Organization

9 "(a) FEDERAL CHARTER.—Military Officers Associa-10 tion of America (in this chapter, the 'corporation'), a non-11 profit organization that meets the requirements for a vet-12 erans service organization under section 501(c)(19) of the 13 Internal Revenue Code of 1986 and is organized under the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, is a federally 14 15 chartered corporation.

16 "(b) EXPIRATION OF CHARTER.—If the corporation does not comply with the provisions of this chapter, the 17 charter granted by subsection (a) shall expire. 18

1 "§ 140402. Purposes

"(a) GENERAL.—The purposes of the corporation are 2 3 as provided in its bylaws and articles of incorporation and 4 include-"(1) to inculcate and stimulate love of the 5 6 United States and the flag; ((2)) to defend the honor, integrity, and su-7 premacy of the Constitution of the United States 8 9 and the United States Government; 10 "(3) to advocate military forces adequate to the 11 defense of the United States; 12 "(4) to foster the integrity and prestige of the 13 Armed Forces; 14 "(5) to foster fraternal relations between all branches of the various Armed Forces from which 15 16 members are drawn: 17 "(6) to further the education of children of 18 members of the Armed Forces; 19 "(7) to aid members of the Armed forces and 20 their family members and survivors in every proper 21 and legitimate manner; "(8) to present and support legislative pro-22 23 posals that provide for the fair and equitable treat-24 ment of members of the Armed Forces, including the 25 National Guard and Reserves, military retirees, fam-26 ily members, survivors, and veterans; and

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"(9) to encourage recruitment and appointment
 in the Armed Forces.

3 "§140403. Membership

4 "Eligibility for membership in the corporation, and
5 the rights and privileges of members of the corporation,
6 are as provided in the bylaws of the corporation.

7 "§ 140404. Governing body

8 "(a) BOARD OF DIRECTORS.—The composition of the 9 board of directors of the corporation, and the responsibil-10 ities of the board, are as provided in the articles of incor-11 poration and bylaws of the corporation.

12 "(b) OFFICERS.—The positions of officers of the cor13 poration, and the election of the officers, are as provided
14 in the articles of incorporation and bylaws.

15 **"§ 140405. Powers**

16 "The corporation has only those powers provided in17 its bylaws and articles of incorporation filed in each State18 in which it is incorporated.

19 "§ 140406. Restrictions

20 "(a) STOCK AND DIVIDENDS.—The corporation may21 not issue stock or declare or pay a dividend.

"(b) DISTRIBUTION OF INCOME OR ASSETS.—The income or assets of the corporation may not inure to the
benefit of, or be distributed to, a director, officer, or member of the corporation during the life of the charter grant-

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ed by this chapter. This subsection does not prevent the
 payment of reasonable compensation to an officer or em ployee of the corporation or reimbursement for actual nec essary expenses in amounts approved by the board of di rectors.

6 "(c) LOANS.—The corporation may not make a loan
7 to a director, officer, employee, or member of the corpora8 tion.

9 "(d) CLAIM OF GOVERNMENTAL APPROVAL OR AU10 THORITY.—The corporation may not claim congressional
11 approval or the authority of the United States Govern12 ment for any of its activities.

13 "(e) CORPORATE STATUS.—The corporation shall
14 maintain its status as a corporation incorporated under
15 the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia.

16 "§140407. Tax-exempt status required as condition of

17 charter

"If the corporation fails to maintain its status as an
organization exempt from taxation under the Internal
Revenue Code of 1986, the charter granted under this
chapter shall terminate.

22 "§ 140408. Records and inspection

- 23 "(a) RECORDS.—The corporation shall keep—
- 24 "(1) correct and complete records of account;

"(2) minutes of the proceedings of the mem bers, board of directors, and committees of the cor poration having any of the authority of the board of
 directors of the corporation; and

5 "(3) at the principal office of the corporation,
6 a record of the names and addresses of the members
7 of the corporation entitled to vote on matters relat8 ing to the corporation.

9 "(b) INSPECTION.—A member entitled to vote on any 10 matter relating to the corporation, or an agent or attorney 11 of the member, may inspect the records of the corporation 12 for any proper purpose at any reasonable time.

13 "§ 140409. Service of process

14 "The corporation shall comply with the law on service15 of process of each State in which it is incorporated and16 each State in which it carries on activities.

17 "§ 140410. Liability for acts of officers and agents

18 "The corporation is liable for any act of any officer19 or agent of the corporation acting within the scope of the20 authority of the corporation.

21 "§ 140411. Annual report

22 "The corporation shall submit to Congress an annual 23 report on the activities of the corporation during the pre-24 ceding fiscal year. The report shall be submitted at the 25 same time as the report of the audit required by section 1 10101(b) of this title. The report may not be printed as
 a public document.

3 **"§ 140412. Definition**

4 "In this chapter, the term 'State' includes the Dis5 trict of Columbia and the territories and possessions of
6 the United States.".

7 (b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of chapters
8 at the beginning of subtitle II of title 36, United States
9 Code, is amended by inserting after the item relating to
10 chapter 1403 the following new item:

"1404. Military Officers Association of America 140401".

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
