- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Standing with Min-
- 5 imum Wage Earners Act of 2007".

## 1 SEC. 2. MINIMUM WAGE.

2	Section 6(a)(1) of the Fair Labor Standards Act of
3	1938 (29 U.S.C. 206(a)(1)) is amended—
4	(1) in subparagraph (B), by striking "and" at
5	the end; and
6	(2) by inserting after subparagraph (C), the fol-
7	lowing:
8	"(D) \$8.00 an hour, beginning on January
9	1, 2010;
10	"(E) \$8.75 an hour, beginning on October
11	1, 2010;
12	"(F) \$9.50 an hour, beginning on July 1,
13	2011; and
14	"(G) beginning on July 1, 2012, and annu-
15	ally adjusted on each July 1 thereafter, the
16	amount of the minimum wage for the year pre-
17	ceding the date of the determination made
18	under this subparagraph, increased by a per-
19	centage equal to the percentage by which the
20	annual rate of pay for Members of Congress in-
21	creased for such year as provided for pursuant
22	to the Legislative Reorganization Act of 1946
23	(2 U.S.C. 31);".
