Mr. REID (for Mrs. CLINTON) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Health, Education, Labor, and Pensions

A BILL

To improve the enforcement of the Davis-Bacon Act.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Davis-Bacon Enforce-
5 ment Act of 2007”.

6 **SEC. 2. ENFORCEMENT OF CERTAIN PREVAILING WAGE**
7 **PROVISIONS.**

8 Section 3146 of title 40, United States Code, is
9 amended by adding at the end the following: “Notwith-
10 standing any other provision of law, any provision of Fed-
11 eral law that requires payment of prevailing wages as de-

1 terminated by the Secretary of Labor in accordance with
 2 subchapter IV of chapter 31, title 40, United States Code,
 3 shall be construed to include the debarment provisions
 4 under section 3144(b)(2) of such title.”.

5 **SEC. 3. DISCLOSURE OF INFORMATION.**

6 (a) GENERAL RULE.—Section 552(a) of title 5,
 7 United States Code, is amended by adding at the end the
 8 following:

9 “(7) The complete payroll records, including all
 10 information contained therein but excluding the So-
 11 cial Security numbers, established under a contract
 12 which is subject to subchapter IV of subtitle II of
 13 chapter 31 of title 40, United States Code, shall be
 14 made available, notwithstanding subsection (b)(6).”.

15 (b) CONSTRUCTION.—Section 552(a) of title 5,
 16 United States Code, shall not be construed to prevent or
 17 prohibit the disclosure required by section 552(a)(7) of
 18 title 5, United States Code, as added by the amendment
 19 made by subsection (a).

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
