A BILL

To prohibit the obligation or expenditure of funds for the Osprey tiltrotor aircraft.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. PROHIBITION ON OBLIGATION OR EXPENDI-
- 4 TURE OF FUNDS FOR THE OSPREY TILT-
- 5 ROTOR AIRCRAFT.
- 6 (a) Prohibition.—Except as provided in subsection
- 7 (b), no amounts appropriated or otherwise made available
- 8 for fiscal year 2008 (or for a fiscal year before fiscal year
- 9 2008 that remain available for obligation) may be obli-
- 10 gated or expended, and no obligated amounts that remain

- 1 available for expenditure may be expended, for the V-22
- 2 or CV-22 Osprey tiltrotor aircraft program.
- 3 (b) Exception for Windup of Program.—
- 4 Amounts covered by the prohibition under subsection (a)
- 5 may be utilized solely for purposes in connection with the
- 6 winding up of the program described in that subsection.
- 7 (c) Repeal of Superseded Authority.—Section
- 8 127 of the John Warner National Defense Authorization
- 9 Act for Fiscal Year 2007 (Public Law 109–364; 120 Stat.
- 10 2109) is repealed.
