4 This Act may be cited as the “SCAAP Reimburse-
5 ment Protection Act of 2008”.

2 **DOCUMENTED ALIENS CHARGED WITH CER-**
3 **TAIN CRIMES.**

5 ality Act (8 U.S.C. 1231(i)(3)(A)) is amended by inserting
6 “charged with or” before “convicted”.
