A BILL

To clarify provisions relating to statutory copyright licenses for satellite carriers.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CLARIFICATION OF STATUTORY COPYRIGHT LI-**

4 **CENSE FOR SATELLITE CARRIERS.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Chapter 1 of title 17, United
6 States Code, is amended by inserting after section 119 the
7 following:

1 **“§ 119A. Clarification of exclusive rights: secondary**
 2 **transmissions of distant network signals**
 3 **for private home viewing by certain sat-**
 4 **ellite carriers**

5 “(a) STATUTORY LICENSE GRANTED.—Notwith-
 6 standing any injunction issued under section
 7 119(a)(7)(B), a satellite carrier found to have engaged in
 8 a pattern or practice of violations under section
 9 119(a)(7)(B) is granted a statutory license to provide a
 10 secondary transmission of a performance or display of a
 11 work embodied in a primary transmission made by a net-
 12 work station in accordance with the provisions of this sec-
 13 tion.

14 “(b) SIGNIFICANTLY VIEWED SIGNALS.—Under the
 15 statutory license granted by subsection (a), a satellite car-
 16 rier may provide a secondary transmission of a primary
 17 transmission made by a network station as provided under
 18 section 119(a)(2)(C)(i).”.

19 (b) TECHNICAL AND CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—
 20 The table of sections for chapter 1 of title 17, United
 21 States Code, is amended by inserting after the item relat-
 22 ing to section 119 the following:

“119A. Clarification of exclusive rights: secondary transmissions of distant net-
 work signals for private home viewing by certain satellite car-
 riers.”.
