## A BILL

To amend title 37, United States Code, to authorize travel and transportation allowances for mobilized members of the reserve components of the Armed Forces on leave for suspension of training or to meet minimal staffing requirements, and for other purposes.

- 3 prescribed by the Secretary of a military department shall
- 4 be subject to the approval of the Secretary of Defense.".
- 5 (2) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of sec-
- 6 tions at the beginning of chapter 7 of such title is
- 7 amended by inserting after the item relating to sec-
- 8 tion 411j the following new item:

"411k. Travel and transportation allowances: travel performed by certain members of the reserve components of the armed forces in connection with leave for suspension of training or to meet minimal staffing requirements.".

- 9 (b) Effective Date.—The amendments made by
- 10 subsection (a) shall take effect on the date of the enact-
- 11 ment of this Act, and shall apply with respect to travel
- 12 that occurs on or after that date
