To ensure that the Sex Offender Registration and Notification Act is applied retroactively.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Sex Offender Registra-
- 5 tion and Notification Retroactivity Correction Act of
- 6 2008".
- 7 SEC. 2. REGISTRY REQUIREMENTS.
- 8 Section 113 of the Sex Offender Registration and No-
- 9 tification Act (42 U.S.C. 16913) shall apply to sex offend-

- 1 ers convicted before, on, or after the date of enactment
- 2 of that Act.

3 SEC. 3. AMENDMENTS TO TITLE 18.

- 4 (a) Failure to Register.—Section 2250(a)(2)(B)
- 5 of title 18, United States Code, is amended by—
- 6 (1) inserting "or has traveled" after "travels";
- 7 (2) inserting "or has entered or left, or resided
- 8 in" before "Indian country"; and
- 9 (3) by inserting ", after conviction of the of-
- fense by reason of which the person is a sex offender
- as defined for the purposes of the Sex Offender Reg-
- istration and Notification Act" after "Indian coun-
- 13 try''.
- 14 (b) Continuing Offense.—Section 2250 of title
- 15 18, United States Code, is amended by adding at the end
- 16 the following:
- 17 "(d) Continuing Offense.—Failure to register or
- 18 update a registration in violation of subsection (a) is a
- 19 continuing offense for as long as such failure exists.".
