A BILL

To provide for the safe redeployment of United States troops from Iraq.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SAFE REDEPLOYMENT OF UNITED STATES
- 4 TROOPS FROM IRAQ.
- 5 (a) Transition of Mission.—The President shall
- 6 promptly transition the mission of the United States
- 7 Armed Forces in Iraq to the limited and temporary pur-
- 8 poses set forth in subsection (d).

1	(b) Commencement of Safe, Phased Redeploy-
2	MENT FROM IRAQ.—The President shall commence the
3	safe, phased redeployment from Iraq of members of the
4	United States Armed Forces who are not essential to the
5	limited and temporary purposes set forth in subsection
6	(d). Such redeployment shall be carried out in a manner
7	that protects the safety and security of the United States
8	Armed Forces.
9	(c) Use of Funds.—Effective 120 days after the
0	date of the enactment of this Act and except as provided
1	in subsection (d), no funds appropriated or otherwise
2	made available under any provision of law may be obli-
3	gated or expended to continue the deployment in Iraq of
4	members of the United States Armed Forces.
5	(d) Exception for Limited and Temporary Pur-
6	POSES.—The prohibition under subsection (c) shall not
7	apply to the obligation or expenditure of funds for the fol-
8	lowing limited and temporary purposes:
9	(1) Conducting targeted operations, limited in
20	duration and scope, against members of al Qaeda
21	and affiliated international terrorist organizations.
22	(2) Providing security for personnel and infra-
)3	structure of the United States Government

(3) Providing training to members of the Iraqi Security Forces who have not been involved in sec-

- tarian violence or in attacks upon the United States
 Armed Forces, provided that such training does not
 involve members of the United States Armed Forces
 taking part in combat operations or being embedded
 with Iraqi forces.
 - (4) Providing training, equipment, or other materiel to members of the United States Armed Forces to ensure, maintain, or improve their safety and security.
- (5) Redeploying members of the United StatesArmed Forces from Iraq.
